### **Brief Description**

The International Chinese Hard Tissue Society (ICHTS) will hold 14th annual meeting conjunct with the 31st Annual Meeting of American Society for Bone and Mineral Research (ASBMR), on September 12, 2009, 6:30-8:40pm, Denver, Colorado. This meeting is designed to provide a forum in which to hear the frontier of advanced topics in recent musculoskeletal research development, to bridge scholars under interdisciplinary research fields, to explore career success experience, and to promote young investigators in the field. To encourage young investigators in this promising research area, at least 3 Webster Jee Young Investigator awards will be awarded and announced in the meeting with an ICHTS Plaque and an award check. Individuals whose abstracts have been accepted to present in the 31st ASBMR meeting are encouraged to submit their accepted abstracts to be considered for the awards.

### **Eligibility:**

1) First author, 2) Status of graduate students, medical students, postdoc or equivalent, junior faculty and professional, and obtained PhD or MD less than 5 years, 3) ICHTS member, and 4) Not received this Award in previous meetings.

Qualified abstracts will be peer reviewed by a nomination committee. The winners will receive an award certificate and an award at the meeting on September 12, 2009. The winner will be expected to highlight their research in the meeting.
