CALL FOR APPLICATION OF WEBSTER JEE YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

**At the 15th Annual Meeting of International Chinese Hard Tissue Society (ICHTS)
In conjunction with 56th ORS Annual Conference**

Brief Description

The International Chinese Hard Tissue Society (ICHTS) will hold 15th annual meeting on March 6, 2010 in conjunction with the 56th Annual Meeting of Orthopaedic Research Society (ORS) at New Orleans, Louisiana. This meeting is organized to provide a forum for ICHTS members to exchange the information in frontiers of recent musculoskeletal research, to bridge the gap of knowledge between the scholars from different research fields, to promote young investigators in the field for successful career developments, and to learn about the career experience from senior researchers. To encourage the participation in the endeavor, at least 3 Webster Jee Young Investigator awards will be given to promising young investigators in this research area during the meeting. Individuals whose abstracts have been accepted to present in the 56th ORS meeting are encouraged to submit their accepted abstracts to be considered for the awards.

Eligibility

- 1) Current ICHTS member
- 2) First author of the submitted ORS abstract
- 3) Current graduate student, medical student, and post-doc or equivalent, junior faculty and professionals who obtained PhD or MD less than 5 years, and
- 4) Has not received the Award previously.

Selection

Abstracts in both blind and un-blind formats should be submitted to the following e-mail addresses: xiaodu.wang@utsa.edu and ichts.org@gmail.com. All submitted abstracts will be peer reviewed in blind by a panel appointed by ICHTS Award Committee. The top three highest scored abstracts will be selected as the winners of Webster Jee Young Investigator Award. The winners will be announced at the meeting and receive an award certificate and a \$500 check at the annual ICHTS meeting on March 6th, 2010 (Applicants have to attend the meeting to be eligible to receive the awards). The winners will be expected to give a short presentation (~5 minutes) to highlight their research in the meeting.
